## Ice breaker

Today we continue at looking at wisdom.

- 1. Let remind ourselves by sharing the
  - a. different people we can look to for wisdom.
  - b. The different places we can go and when
- 2. a. What priority for wisdom was Moses looking for? Read Ex 33:33

b Discuss the benefits and blessings Moses received from receiving the above from the Lord in His ministry to the people of Israel.

- 3. a. What priority in life was Solomon looking for from God? Read 1 Kings 3:5-6,9
  b How did God respond? 1 Kings 3:11-13
  c What does the above teach us how God is with us today?
- 4. What wisdom are you wanting at this time in your life? If you feel able/safe/appropriate after reflecting on this share with your small group.
- 5. Read 1 Corinthians 2:6-9

Paul is speaking to mature Christians vs 6. Describe and discuss your understanding of the qualities of a mature Christian. You may find other Scriptures helpful.

- 6. Throughout Church history there is a pressure in society for Christians to adjust their faith, so it fits in with the current philosophies of the day. Do you discern any today? If so, what are they?
- 7. Read 1 Corinthians 2 vs 10-16. How does the Holy Spirit help us to grow in wisdom and understanding? You may want to draw on other Scriptures.

You may want to end by asking how we can best respond as an individual and as a group to receive more of the Holy Spirit in our lives. This could include a short time of being open to the Spirit ministering into your lives.
