1. From the reading, and talks, discuss who God uses to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem.
- 2a. Today we are Rebuilding our world, at the heart of it is renewing to spiritual life of people towards God and renewal of all that is broken.
- b. Brainstorm all the different types of people God could use to rebuild our world.
- c. Discuss the benefits of having such a diverse group of people.
- d. What are some of the challenges inviting others different to you to volunteer with you?
- 3a. How can you/your team best invest in the team you are in? You may want to discuss this with your team.
- b. Who refused to participate in the rebuilding and why? Read Nehemiah v 5
- c. What reason can we give not to be involved in Gods work?
- d. How can we solve part b? for ourselves. You may be able to think of scriptures to help you.
- e. Notice Jesus's approach to rebuilding our world. Philippians 2: 3-11
4. What qualities did those who rolled up their sleeves have, and how did it help them do their jobs well? Read Nehemiah 2v 5,18 4v 9 and 4v6
5. The Israelites were called by God to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem.
